SEPTIC TANK PUMP OUTS

Please call The Village Shop @**306-984-2358** and leave a message. State your name, lot and block # and your full civic address

Messages are checked @ **8:00 am** and **1:00 pm**. The phone is not checked after that until the next day Please call a couple days before you need a pumpout to allow enough time for our septic driver to get to it. On September 1 our septic service changed to 5 days a week Monday to Friday There will be no service on Statutory holidays There are no emergency or after hour pumpouts It is **your** responsibility as a home owner to contact the **Village Shop** to have your tank emptied out

Please do not assume that your tank is empty in the spring, please call in before you arrive to ensure that if it has been a wet spring your tank will be empty and you can enjoy your stay.

Clear access to your holding tank is required for all pump outs or service will be denied. Example: Vehicles, dogs at large, snow, trailers, etc.)

We ask that you affix house numbers to your home or property in order to assist our staff to properly attend to your requests. This will be extremely helpful in the event of a **Police, Fire or Medical emergency**.

Garbage pickup is every Tuesday Pick up will change to every second Tuesday starting in November. **Recycle** pickup is once a month. **Schedules are found on our website**

BUILDING PERMITS

Building Permits are required for **ALL** buildings, including decks that are larger than 99.9 sq ft. and all covered decks, regardless of size. The removal of buildings require a permit and Sask Energy **must** be notified before removal. Permits are available from the Village office and they must be approved by Council **before** any work begins.

There are 4 Commercial Lots available for sale. Call the office for more information.

An Oil Pickup Station has been placed beside the Transfer Station. Used auto oil and filters are accepted at \$1.00 per drop off Please pay at the office

BOAT DOCK LIFT STORAGE

The Village of Chitek Lake would like to offer tax payers the opportunity to store boat dock lift over the winter season in the boat launch parking lot Storage for boat lifts only will be available until May1,2022 at \$200 per space Please contact Village Office @306-984-2353 for more information

TAXES AND BOAT DOCK FEES

Just a reminder that all taxes and boat dock leases must be paid by December 31,2021

Also Provincial laws require any changes to the **shoreline**, tree removal or construction of a dock/deck **must** have **permits approved** by The Water Security Agency and the Resort Village of Chitek Lake.

All **dogs require a dog licence at a cost of \$5.00** and must be on a leash, tied up or fenced within your property
